Accomplished

1. SwA SIG was chartered on Monday Feb. 12/06 (ab/06-02-01)
 - ♣ The primary mission of the SwA SIG is to work within the OMG and other industry groups, to establish a common framework for analysis and exchange of information related to software trustworthiness.
 - ♣ The goals of the SIG are
 - ♣ Facilitate the development of a specification for a Software Assurance Framework
 - ♣ Enable industry to improve visibility into the current status of software assurance during development of its software
 - ♣ Enable industry to develop automated tools that support the common framework
 - ♣ Leverage other related OMG specifications such as KDM, SPEM, ...
 - ♣ Promote the use of OMG specifications in the development of secure software
 - ♣ Find ways to leverage the various quality and maturity models for security with OMG specifications.
2. SwA information session was held on Wednesday, Feb. 15/06
 - ♣ Session was well attended – around 45 people representing 33 different organizations
 - ♣ Good variety of speakers from different sectors
